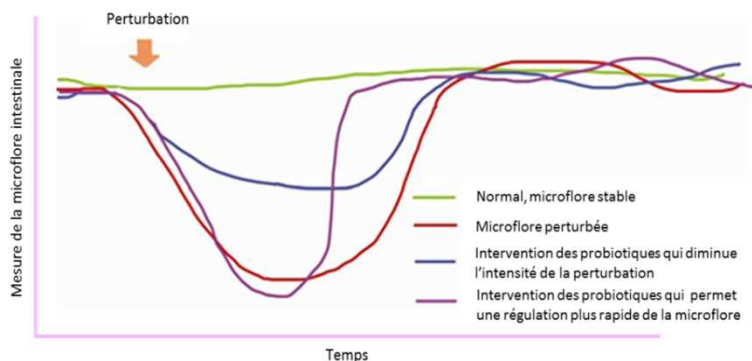


Formulated with Malt and Paraffin, PHYTOMALT is a digestive stimulant that helps eliminate ingested hair and lubricates the digestive tract to prevent constipation, regurgitation and the formation of new hairballs. Enriched with Probiotics, PHYTOMALT helps optimize the intestinal flora balance for a better digestive comfort.

MALT EXTRACT. Cats spend a lot their day maintaining their fur. The constant licking leads to the swallowing of hairs, which form into hairballs of varying sizes in the stomach. Malt extract supports the natural expulsion of swallowed hair.

PARAFFIN OIL is a stimulant laxatives typically used to lubricate the digestive tract. Hence, paraffin oil prevents the formation of hairballs in the stomach and helps to treat constipation cause by them.

PROBIOTICS : YEAST is an unicellular fungi of the genus *Saccharomyces*, especially *S. cerevisiae*. Yeast are living microorganisms, which when administered in adequate amounts confer health benefit on the host. Probiotics can directly influence colonizing microbes through multiple mechanisms, including the production of inhibitory compounds (bacteriocins, short chain fatty acids, and others), by producing substrates that might promote the growth of colonizing microbes (fatty acids, vitamins, ...) and by promoting immune responses against specific microbes.

Nutrition Ingredients: Aqua, Vegetable Glycerin, Malt Extract, Liquid paraffin, Yeasts, Xanthan gum (E415), E202, E211, Citric acid.



Directions for use: Shake before use. Mix 2.5 ml in the drinking water or with your cat food. Suggested treatment period: 1 to 2 months. Can be renewed several times a year if necessary. PHYTOMALT can be combined with other PHYTOCARE products. It is recommended to not exceed the indicated daily doses. Food supplements cannot substitute a varied diet. Keep out of the reach of children. Store in a cool and dry place, avoid exposure to direct sunlight. Hints: Brush your cat regularly to help eliminate dead hair and prevent its ingestion.
